

Patrick Murphy is vice president of the Mobile Division for Alabama Power Company, an electric utility that provides reliable, affordable electricity to more than 1.4 million customers across the state. Murphy represents the Mobile Division through external and community affairs, implementing growth initiatives that generate revenue through sales, economic development and community development.

Murphy is the past president of the Economic Development Association of Alabama.
