**MEETING NOTES:**

*These notes summarize the major discussion items and are not intended to be a transcript or analysis of the meeting.*

Dave opened the meeting by reviewing the various drafts of the Martin Shoreline Management Program (SMP) that MIG 4 members have commented on previously. Dave then reviewed the new sections of the complete draft of the SMP, focusing on the Executive Summary, revised Introduction, recommended BMPs, the Vector and Aquatic Plant Management Program, and the Implementation and Review cycle. MIG members had a few questions regarding the shoreline BMPs and suggested adding one regarding time of day to water the landscape.

Dave then reviewed the appendices, including the draft shoreline classification maps. Jim Crew introduced two changes to the maps that will be made, including bringing an island into the Project and additional lands in the Jaybird Landing area that will be used for a hunting area. Dave mentioned that there will be some additional reclassifications as a results of the Recreation Plan and any data provided regarding sensitive resources.

The MIG then discussed comments received on the SMP including the littering issue on Project lands and the restriction on future bridges on Lake Martin. Alabama Power is proposing to support litter removal efforts and will respond to litter issues as they are reported. Alabama Power is also proposing to notify stakeholders of new bridge applications brought forth under the Standard Land Use article. Additional information will be provided in future versions of the SMP.

Dave then focused the groups attention on the draft Recreation Plan. Dave focused on the Recreation Plan outline and the sections that will have to be completed based on use estimates for 2009/2010. Dave then reviewed the proposed recreation improvements. The group then addressed comments received from MIG members.
