Dear Mr. Crews,

Central Elmore Water and Sewer Authority (CEW&SA) has completed a review of the MIG 2 Study Plan 9 “Location of Permitted Discharges on Lake Martin”. Our review indicated that CEW&SA’s NPDES permit was not included in the study nor was it included in the maps provided on the CD. CEW&SA has held an NPDES permit with the Alabama Department of Environmental Management since 1997. The most current NPDES permit expired in 2007, but has been administratively extended by ADEM. We have received the renewed permit and a copy has been included with this letter. The permit includes discharges into an unnamed stream which does terminate into Lake Martin. The NPDES permitted site is located at our treatment facility at 65 Lake Point Road in Eclectic.

CEW&SA feels that this permitted site should be included in the report since there could be advantages to replacing the withdrawn water into the reservoir. If you have any questions, feel free to give me a call.
