Dear E1 Issue Action Group Member:

Each of you should have received an announcement for the May 21 & 22, 2002 Coosa-Warrior relicensing meetings. The first day will be a joint meeting of the EcoRAT, WCRT and RecRAT. Part of the information shared at that meeting will include a review of the IAGs' progress to date.
