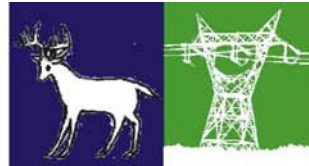
SHORELINE CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM

- APC Project Operations
- Recreation
- Multiple Use Lands (owned and not owned by APC)
- Sensitive Resources Lands
- Natural / Undeveloped Lands
- Forest Service Lands



MODIFICATIONS TO THE LAKE SHORE USE PERMITTING PROGRAM

- Rip-rap must be placed in front of all newly constructed seawalls
- New permittees will have to maintain a 15 foot (minimum) buffer zone on all APC owned project lands
- Implementation of residential permit fees
- Requirement of bonded contractors



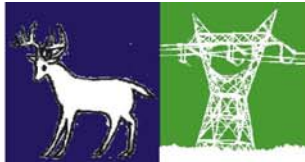

APC COST OF PROCESSING

RESIDENTIAL LAKE SHORE USE PERMITS

- Alabama Power Shoreline Management Personnel & Administrative Costs
- Residential Permit Application Processing & Site Visits
- Monitoring and Enforcement

Total Cost per Residential Permit = Approximately \$317
