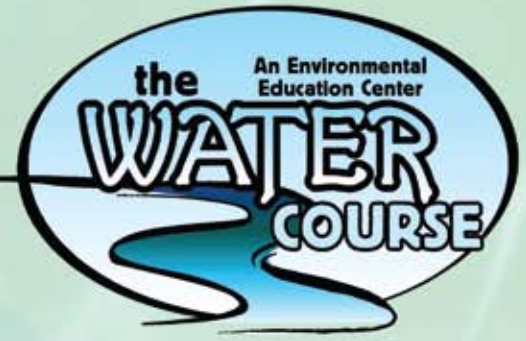

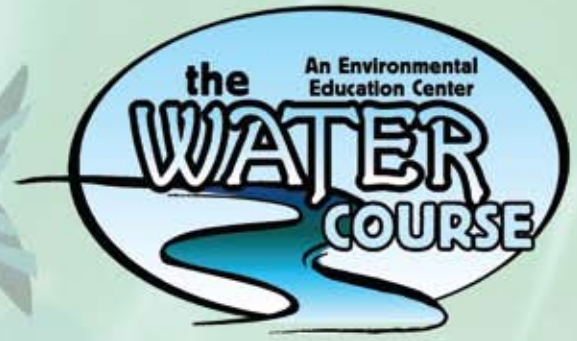

1. How much of the Earth's surface is covered by water? **About 70%** (First, There Was Water)
2. How many gallons of water does the average person use in a five minute shower? (Waste Not, Want Not)  
Circle your answer: 20 **25** 30 gallons  
**The average shower uses 5 gallons per minute:  $5 \times 5 = 25$  gallons**
3. Alabama has the same amount of navigable waterways as California. True **False** (Water Course One) **Alabama has MORE navigable waterways than any other state.**
4. A river can be described as a **liquid** highway. (Water Course One)
5. How does trash get into our waterways? **People throw their trash into the water or the trash is brought by runoff and storm water** (Renew Our Rivers)
6. Why should you limit the number of fish in a lake or pond? (Who Does What – Fish Management) **Limiting the number of fish will keep the population healthy.**
7. How long did the plastic container in the "Message in the Bottle" exhibit stay in the water before it was found? **For at least 19 years** (Message in the Bottle)
8. Which river flows through Mitchell Dam? **The Coosa River flows through Mitchell Dam.** (Mitchell Dam Tour)
9. What is the only compound we use as a solid, a liquid, and a gas every day? **Water; ice is solid; water is liquid; and steam is a gas.** (Water Whys – Facts)
10. In what kind of forest do Red-Cockaded Woodpeckers make their nests? **In old-growth longleaf pine forests** (Red-Cockaded Woodpecker Exhibit in Lobby)
