#### AVAILABILITY

Available in all areas served from the interconnected system of the Company.

### APPLICABILITY

Applicable, when appropriate, upon request, to any seasonal use of lighting and power service (except air conditioning) requiring a capacity of at least 25 kW. Short-Term Service means a recurring variation, due to the seasonal character of the Consumer's business, in capacity required by such Consumer from month to month in each successive year and does not include any temporary variation in capacity used by a Consumer whose business would not ordinarily be classed as seasonal. The otherwise applicable rate will be modified to the extent set forth below.

#### MONTHLY RATE

The charge for billing capacity in the applicable rate will be increased by:

75 cents per kilowatt (or kVA)

#### **DETERMINATION OF CAPACITY BILLED**

The kilowatt or kilovolt-ampere capacity for billing purposes will be the maximum integrated fifteen (15) minute measured capacity during each service month, regardless of capacities established in preceding months or of the capacity required to be maintained. In no event shall the minimum billing capacity (kW or kVA) be less than the minimum of the appropriate rate.

#### MINIMUM BILL

The standard minimum charge in the otherwise applicable rate shall be suspended and the annual minimum charge shall be forty-five dollars (\$45.00) per kW (or kVA) of maximum capacity required during the previous eleven (11) months or of the capacity required to be maintained, whichever is greater, plus applicable provisions of Rate T.
