

## SPECIAL RULES GOVERNING THE APPLICATION OF RATE TST - THERMAL SYSTEMS TIME-OF-USE

By order of the Alabama Public Service Commission dated April 4, 2006 in Informal Docket #U-3545.

- 1. Rate TST is designed for commercial and industrial customers that invest in thermal systems such as, cool storage (excluding chilled water), heat storage (space heating), and high capacity water heating including electric and electrode boilers.
- 2. Plans for the thermal system must be reviewed by Alabama Power Company before service commences under Rate TST. For new thermal systems, the plans should be submitted to the Company before installation has begun.
- 3. The thermal system equipment billed under this rate must be wired and metered completely separate from the other load of the customer. This is subject to inspection at anytime by Alabama Power Company employees. Violations will result in all previous usage billed on Rate TST being rebilled on the standard rate applicable to the remaining customer load with any difference becoming due immediately. Also, Rate TST would no longer be applicable to any load at that premise.
- 4. The customer is responsible for wiring the thermal system equipment to accommodate a separate meter.
