RATE RIDER IC INTERRUPTIBLE CAPACITY



By order of the Alabama Public Service Commission dated October 3, 2023, in Docket U-5453

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AVAILABILITY

Available to qualifying Industrial and Commercial Customers, as those classifications are described in Company's Rules and Regulation for Electric Service, who enter into a Contract for Electric Service ("Contract") and an Interruptible Power Agreement ("Interruptible Agreement") for service within the interconnected system of the Company.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable for lighting, power and miscellaneous electric service when the Customer's entire electrical requirements are served by the Company and can be operated by Customer in such a manner that Customer can, upon notice from Company, reduce its electric service requirements to a predetermined firm capacity level.

Absent authorization by the Commission, service under this rate rider shall not be combined with any current or future time advantage, time of use or real time pricing rate.

INTERRUPTIBLE CAPACITY DESIGNATION, MONTHLY CREDIT FOR INTERRUPTIBLE CAPACITY, AND SUSPENSION PERIOD OPTIONS

Customer shall designate the amount of interruptible capacity and firm capacity (on a kW or kVA basis, consistent with how Customer is charged for capacity). The designated interruptible capacity shall be subject to suspension upon not less than thirty (30) minutes' notice limited by the option selected by Customer. In exchange for designating an amount of interruptible capacity, and depending on the suspension option selected, Customer shall receive a corresponding monthly credit.

Standard (Option 1)

Interruptible Capacity Credit:

\$2.55 per kW per Month or \$2.30 per kVA per Month Maximum Cumulative Suspension Hours per Year: 200 Hours Maximum Length of a Suspension Period: 8 Hours

Maximum Number of Suspensions per Week: 5 Suspensions





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Option 2

Interruptible Capacity Credit:

\$2.02 per kW per Month or \$1.82 per kVA per Month

Maximum Cumulative Suspension Hours per Year: 100 Hours Maximum Length of a Suspension Period: 8 Hours

Maximum Number of Suspensions per Week: 3 Suspensions

Option 3

Interruptible Capacity Credit:

\$0.98 per kW per Month or \$0.88 per kVA per Month

Maximum Cumulative Suspension Hours per Year: 50 Hours
Maximum Length of a Suspension Period: 8 Hours
Maximum Number of Suspensions per Week: 1 Suspension

NON-COMPLIANCE PENALTY

Failure by Customer to comply during a suspension period, in whole or part, shall result in a non-compliance penalty, which shall be calculated as follows:

Calculated as:

- (i) the positive difference between the Customer's actual fifteen (15) minute kW or kVA demand, as applicable, and the firm capacity for a Suspension Period;
- (ii) the sum of the positive values in (i.) divided by four; and
- (iii) the calculated value in (ii.) multiplied by the applicable Non-Compliance Penalty (\$15.30 per kW or \$13.80 per kVA).

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TERM

Unless otherwise agreed to by Company, Customer may not convert interruptible capacity to firm capacity without a minimum of two (2) years written notice of its intention to do so.

GENERAL

Service under this rate rider is subject to the rules and regulations approved or prescribed by the Alabama Public Service Commission.
