

Jill Stork is the vice president of Alabama Power's Western Division, overseeing community and economic development initiatives and external affairs for West Alabama. The Western Division includes 14 counties and 78 municipalities, serving over 235,000 Alabama Power customers.

After earning a degree in electrical engineering from the University of Alabama in 1995, Stork began her career at Alabama Power as a distribution engineer in the Mobile Division. In 2001, she moved to the Southern Division as the Engineering supervisor for the Dadeville/Lake Martin area, managing engineers and line crews in the region. Later, she transitioned to the Southeast Division, where she handled accounting and customer service across nine business offices and led community development efforts. During her time in the Wiregrass area, she returned to Power Delivery as the Operations manager, overseeing safe and reliable operations and construction for regions including Eufaula, Ozark, Enterprise and Headland.

In 2009, Stork returned to the Mobile Division as Operations manager for the South and East Operations, managing engineers, line crews and underground network operations. In 2014, she became the manager of the Division Distribution Control Center, overseeing division-wide local operation linemen and the safe and reliable operations of the electric grid serving the entire Mobile Division.
