

Moses Feagin is Alabama Power's executive vice president, treasurer and chief financial officer, where he oversees the Accounting and Finance departments, as well as Regulatory Affairs (AFR).

Feagin brings more than 35 years of experience to the role. Previously, he served as senior vice president, treasurer, chief financial officer and chief diversity officer for Mississippi Power.
