In 2010, he joined Alabama Power in the role of assistant-to the senior vice president and senior production officer and has since progressed through management roles in Alabama Power's Resource Planning and Regulatory Affairs organizations.

He is a graduate of Leadership Hoover's Class of 2024, was the president of the board of directors for Shades Mountain Community Park in Hoover from 2017-2020 and was president of the Kiwanis Club of Metropolitan Birmingham.
